Dear Parents

“Greetings from IIS Dammam”.

It is observed that students who are using private transport are moving out of the school campus in the afternoon and spreading to the nearby areas. Complaints are received from families living around the school that our students are going and disturbing them. It is also conveyed that the private vehicles are banging horns loudly and causing disturbance to the elderly people in the nearby families.

Hence it is strictly instructed that no students should go out of the school campus after the dispersal of the school at 1:30 p.m. Students have to stay inside the school campus and parents can pick them from the stipulated gates. Private commuters should use Gate Nos – 4, 5, 7 or 8 in order to board the vehicles. School will not be responsible for any consequences because of the children going out of the campus and roaming around.

This is to be strictly followed by all private drivers and parents who are coming to pick their wards from the school.
