'Has' is used for a single (one) person or a thing except for 'YOU' and 'I'.

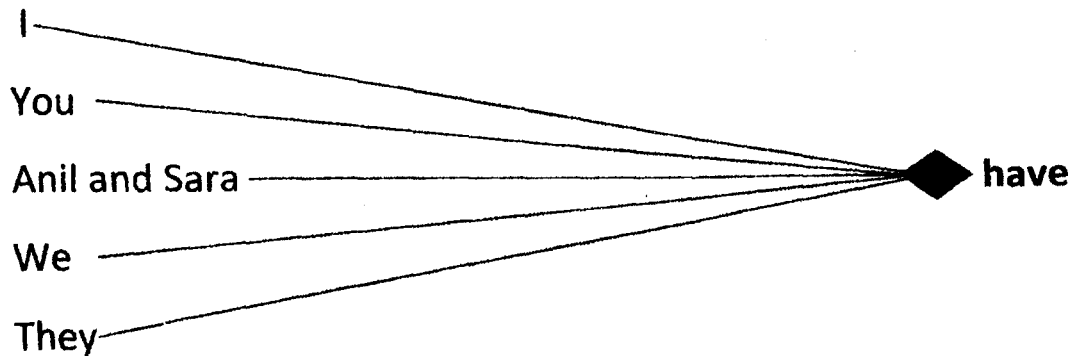


- e.g: 1. Sara has a red frock.

3. It has a long neck.

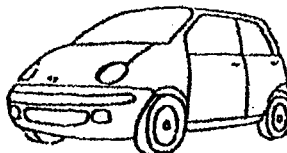


INTRODUCTION: USE OF "HAVE"

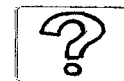
Full Stop:

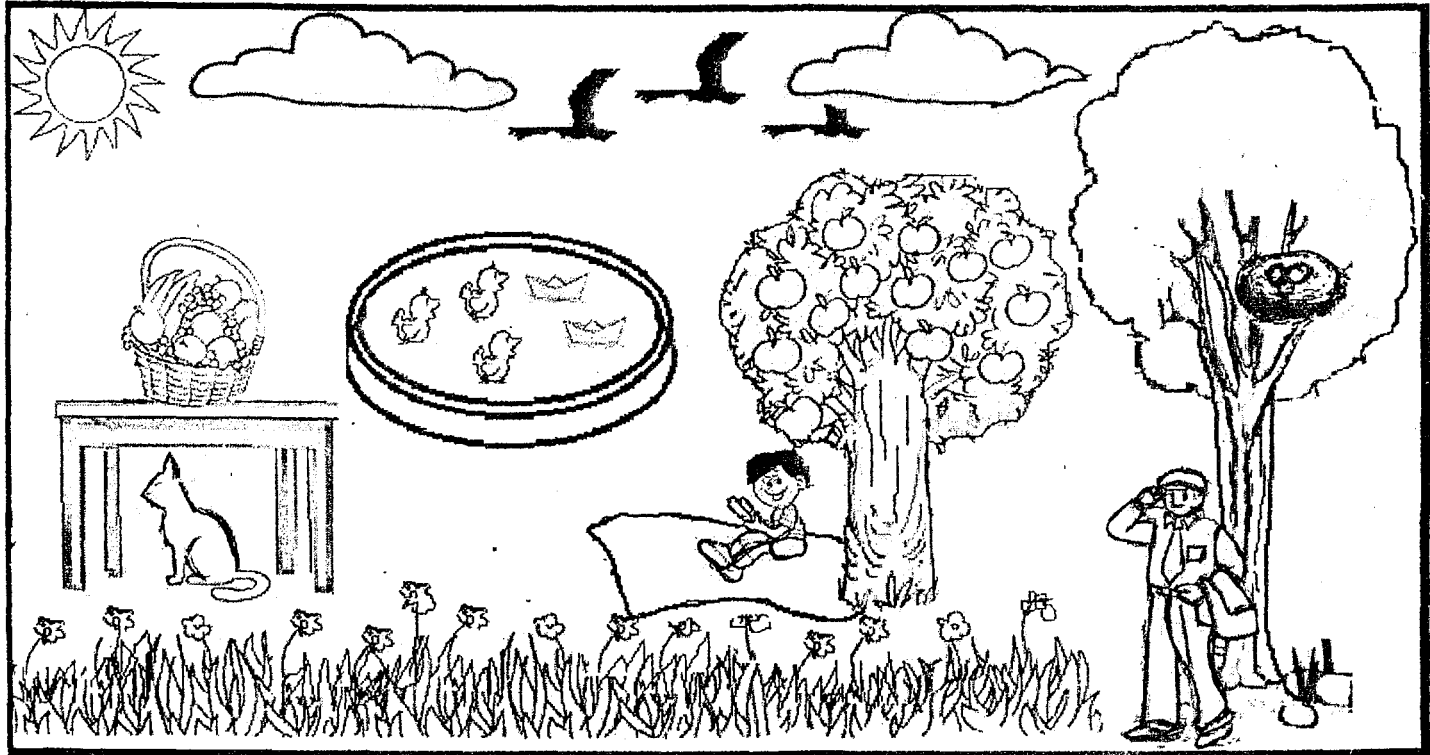

What is a sentence?

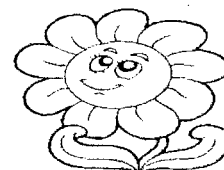
A group of words put together to make sense is called as a sentence.

Guidelines for framing sentences:

- a) Begin the sentence with a **capital letter**.
- b) End the sentence with a **full stop** or a **question mark**.
- c) The sentence framed should be grammatically correct and make sense.



Example: The cat is sitting on a mat. (✓)

The cat on a mat sitting. (X)

d) Avoid framing sentences beginning with 'I', 'This' or 'That'

e) Underline the word used in framing the sentence.

Note: The given words have to be used to make a sentence, changes like play - plays, read - reads can be used. **Please do not change the given words by adding "ing" or "ed".**
