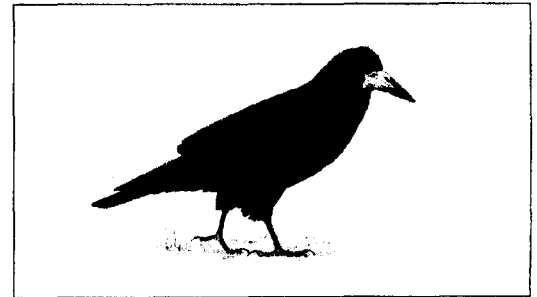
The Rooks
