

**CIRCULAR**

**SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME (SSS) FOR THE STUDENTS OF IIS DAMMAM**

Dear Parents

Greeting from IISD

Considering the current pandemic and financial hardships being faced by the Indian Diaspora, a School Scholarship Scheme (SSS) has been instituted in International Indian School, Dammam to economically support parents. The Scheme shall be run as a pilot project initially and may be reviewed after a period of one academic year.

It shall be an internal scheme ratified and applied objectively, on case to case basis, through Principal, MC with the final approval of the Higher Board.

**The scheme is applicable for students in classes VI and above.**

The application forms for the SSS is available at the school reception. It can also be downloaded from the school website.

Following criteria shall be applied for the consideration of SSS to a student:

1. The scheme applies to Indian citizens only.
2. It is not an open scholarship. It is expected that only needy parents should apply for consideration.
3. Parents should have applied for the grant of SSS on the designated form and fulfilled the economic criteria and verifications.
4. Of the applicants, parents receiving the lowest aggregate salary (together for the father and mother), will be considered as the benchmark, and applications will be accordingly incrementally considered. In no case, the difference in aggregate salary between the applicants should exceed SR 500. For example, if the lowest aggregate salary per month of a couple is SR 2500, the consideration for that academic year will be for the parents whose aggregate salary is between SR 2500 and SR 3000.
5. SSS will be considered for student numbers not exceeding 2% in a specific class. For example, if there are 300 students in Class 10 of a particular school, SSS will be granted to a maximum of 2% of 300 or 6 students irrespective of the number of applicants.

SSS will be extended separately to boys and girls sections.

Applicant children should have been studying in the IIS for at least two years before seeking first consideration. Cases not considered during the first year may be reconsidered for the next year.



8. The consideration will be held once in the academic year unless reviewed.
9. The scheme shall not apply to students of Class 5 and below.
10. SSS will be applied to only one child from a family. No two siblings will be considered for the grant of the SSS.
11. SSS will be granted for a maximum of two successive years and reviewed thereafter. There has to be a period of two years before the parent can reapply for consideration under the scheme.
12. The only consideration for the grant of SSS will be the economic conditions of the parents and no other criteria such as academic performance, sports achievements, extracurricular activities or miscellaneous aspects will be applied for considerations.

**Parents are required to furnish written documents for their collective proof of income (husband and wife), duly attested from their employers and General Organization for Social Insurance certificate reflecting their salary. In the absence of either of the two, the application will not be considered.**

**Based on final approvals the SSS will be granted at the scale of 50% of the aggregate monthly fee.**
