**For ex: an apple, an egg, an inkpot, an orange etc.**

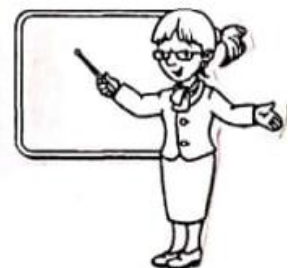
