

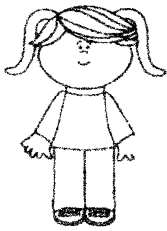

Nouns are the names of people, places, animals and things.



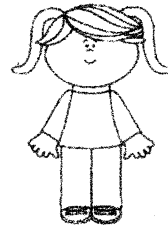

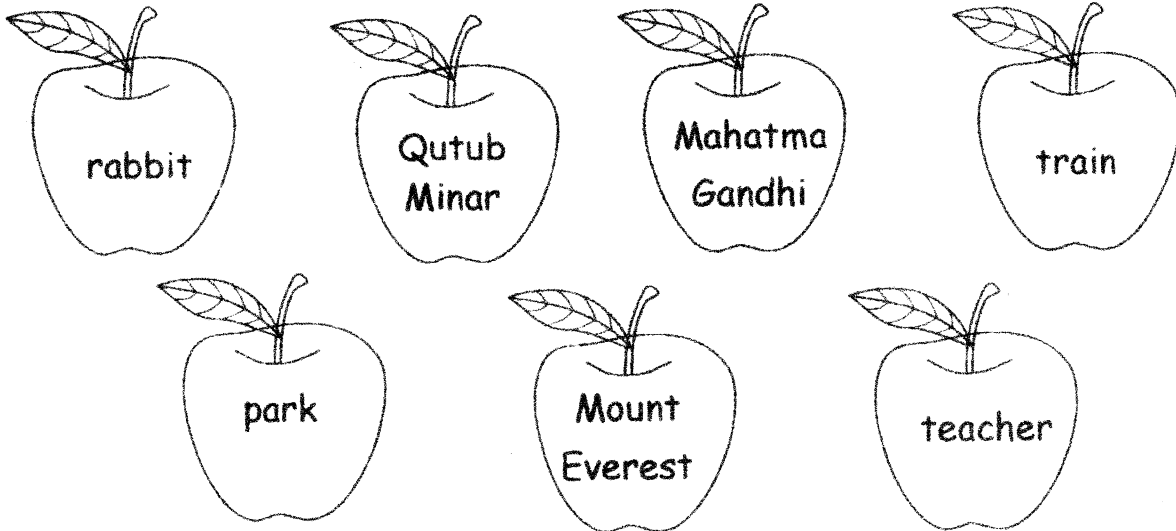
