PRONOUNS

Pronouns are words used in place of nouns.
 Words like **he**, **she**, **it** and **they** are used instead of nouns. They are called **pronouns**.

Example : **Ravi** is a boy. **Ravi** has a bicycle.

Instead of this we can write:

Ravi is a boy. **He** has a bicycle.

He is a pronoun. It takes the place of the noun "**Ravi**".
