

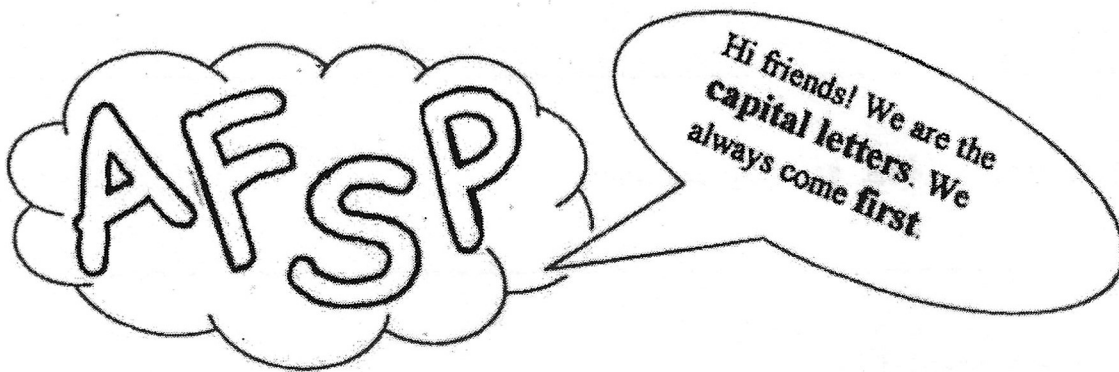

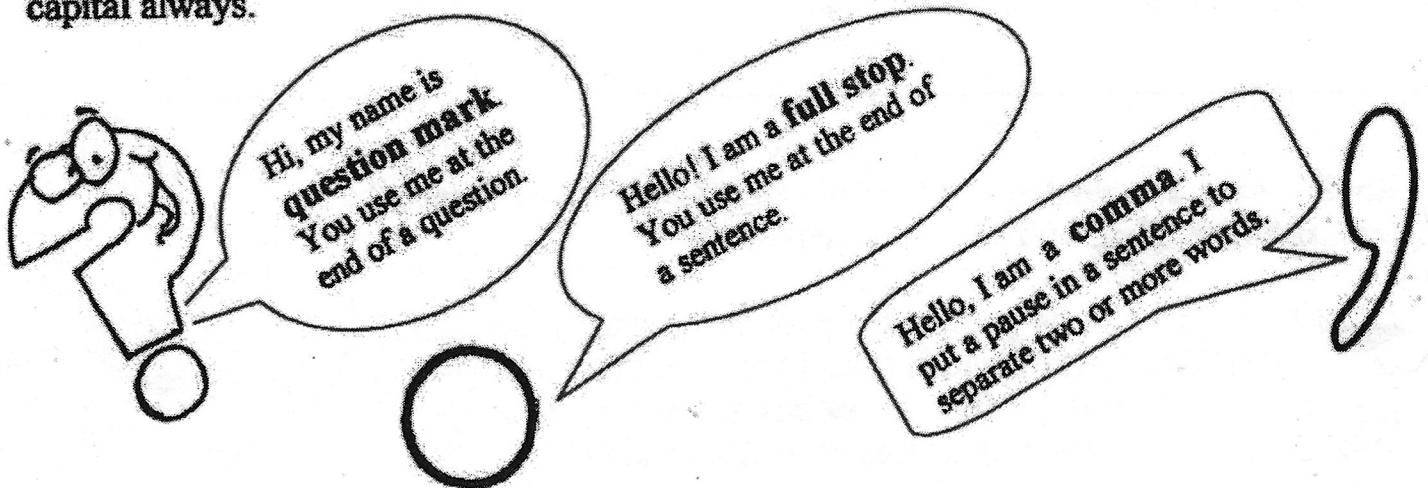
PUNCTUATIONS

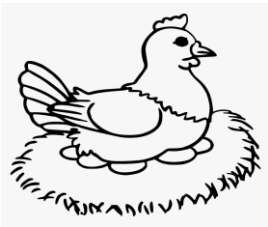
