CLASS X BOARD RESULTS

The result of Class X have been exceedingly impressive with 100% in 2019. 406 boys appeared at Class X. In terms of grade points 43 students secured 90% and above, while 106 students secured 80% and above, 98 students secured 70% and above and the remaining below 70%.
