| DELETE KEY | This key is also used to erase the character, but to the right side of the cursor. |


| ENTER KEY | There are two Enter keys on the keyboard which are <br> used to move the cursor to the next line. |

## Working of a Computer

A computer works in three basic steps: Input, Process \& Output (IPO cycle)

| INPUT DEVICES | PROCESS DATA | OUTPUT DEVICES |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| A computer receives data or instructions through the input devices. | The entered data is processed or changed into meaningful information by the CPU (Central Processing Unit). | The result of processing is known as output. The output is displayed through the output devices. |
