ALPHABET KEYS

NUMBER KEYS



There are 10 number keys that are used to enter numbers into the computer.

ARROW KEYS



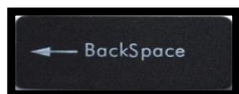
Arrow keys are used to move the cursor in different directions. Cursor is a small blinking line on the monitor.

SPACEBAR



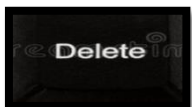
This is the longest key on the keyboard. It will give a blank space to the right of the character.

BACKSPACE KEY





It is used to erase the character to the left side of the cursor.

DELETE KEY



This key is also used to erase the character, but to the right side of the cursor.

<p align="center"><u>CAPS LOCK KEY</u></p> 	<p>This key is used to write the alphabet in capital.</p>

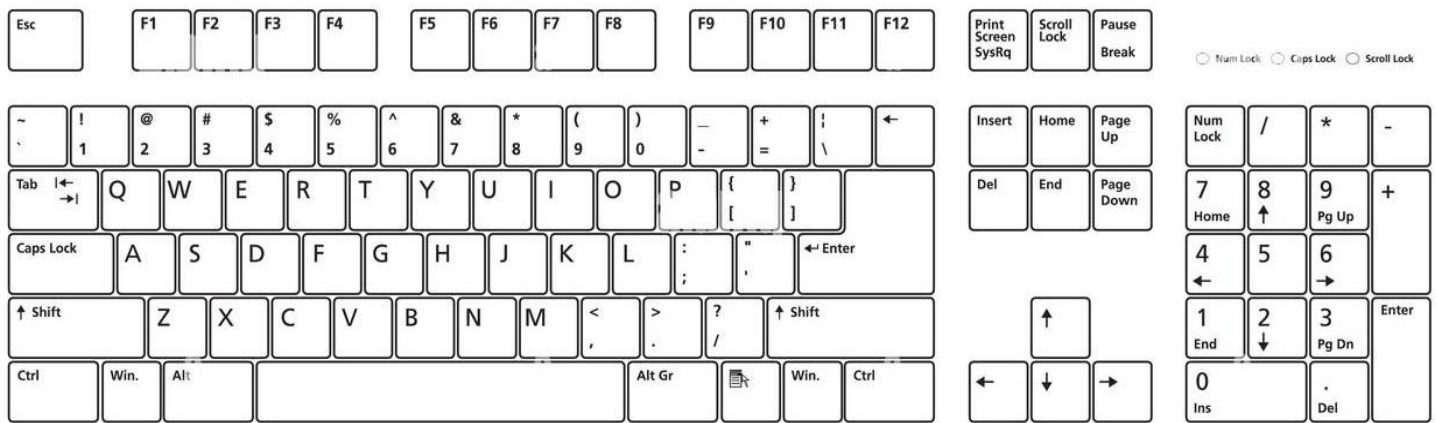



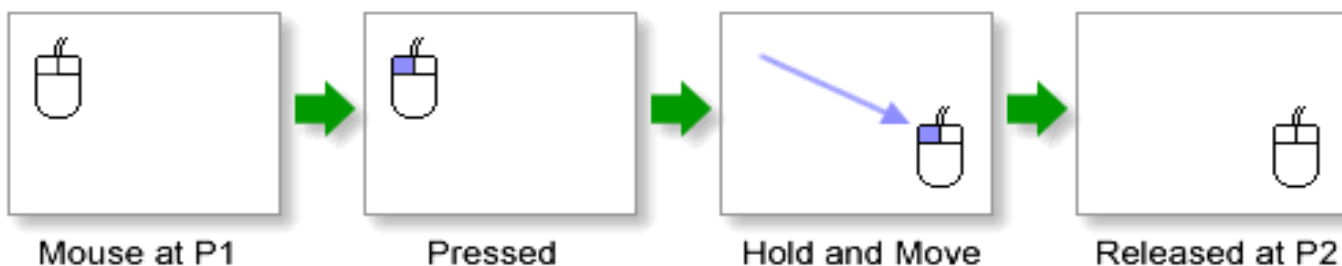

This function is used to move an item from one place to another on the monitor.

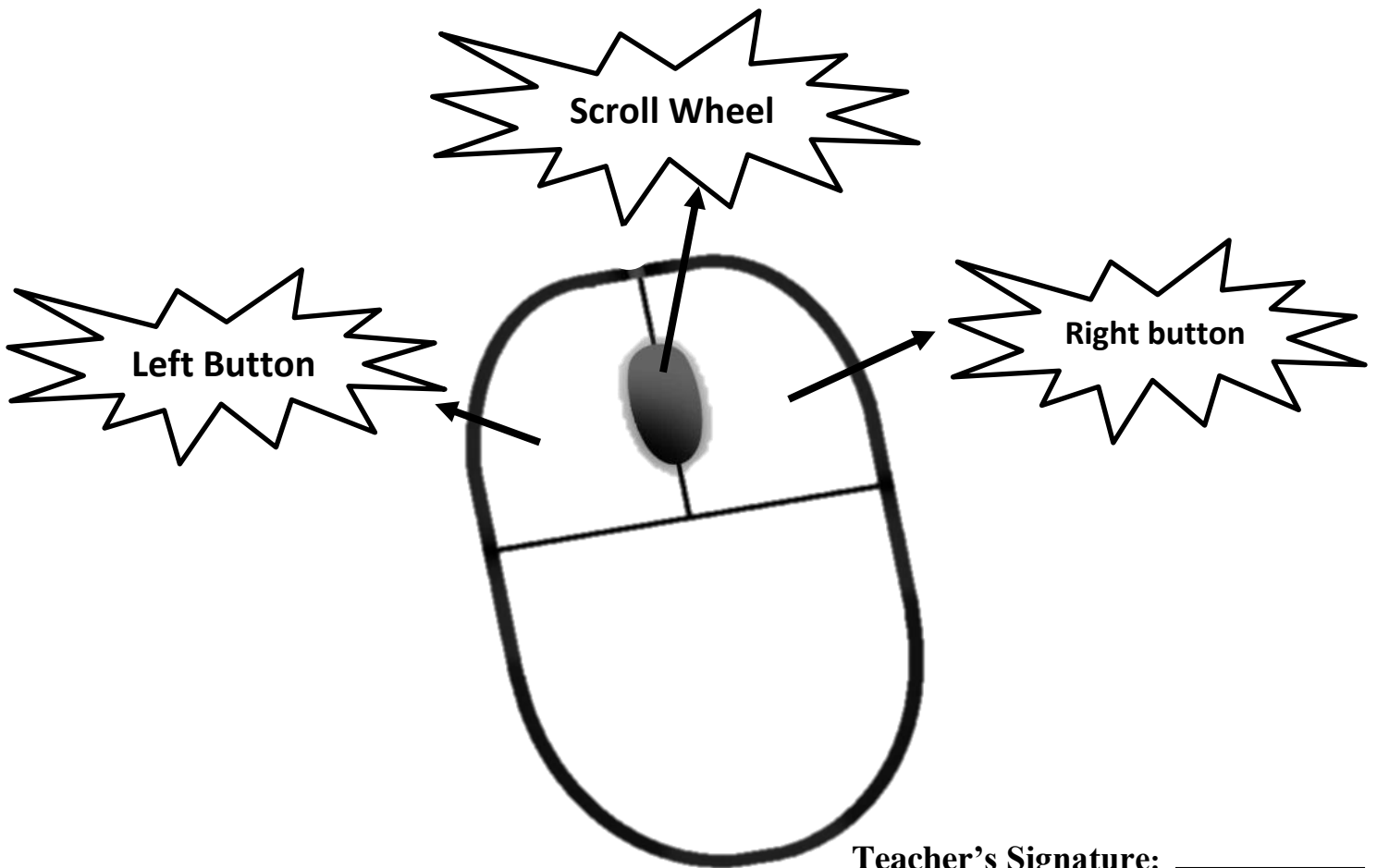








Working of a Computer
