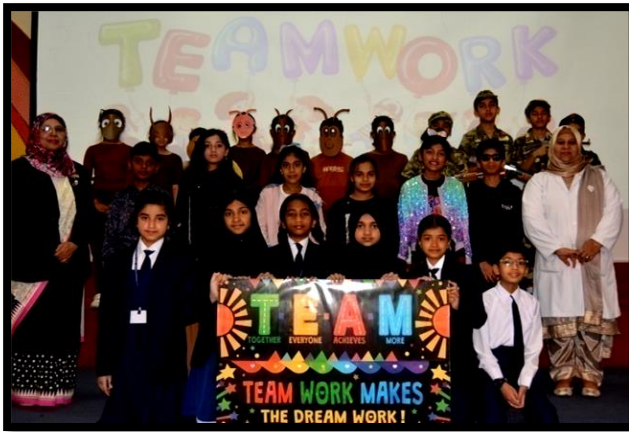
Every effort is made to provide enriching platforms where young talents can explore and excel—whether in academics, sports, social development, or moral responsibility.
