Evaluation depends upon the achievement of individual goals planned every six months. Academically, high achievers are mainstreamed and others are trained for skills and vocational enhancement.

ACTIVITIES OF THE SCHOOL

Morning Assembly

The morning assembly denotes an auspicious way to begin the day. It includes a prayer song, pledge, group singing with music and actions with words of advise from the Supervisor.





Special Assemblies

Special assemblies are organized by group of teachers and their classes to mark solemn occasions like Gandhi Jayanti, Republic Day, Saudi National Day, Labour Day, Children's Day etc. The programme presented imparts the message and meaning of the event effectively to our tiny tots.









ACADEMICS

Language:

The bond between the teacher and the child is deep and its impact is far-reaching and fruitful. A lot of time and individual attention is paid to lay a strong foundation through Phonic Drill, Sensorial exercises and Pattern writing. As a result, Verbal skills and Communication in English improves rapidly irrespective of one's mother tongue. Multimedia lessons are shown to improve their verbal and recognition skills.





Number Work:

The aim of each teacher is to create an environment to ensure that education is not only received but also achieved. To begin with, our tiny tots learn to recognize numbers and use them in daily life. Different apparatus like Seguin board, Flash Cards are used to help the child identify and learn to recognize numbers well.





Introduction of a New Language – Hindi:

To make this subject easy and interesting, we use different kinds of teaching aids such as charts, flash cards, Hindi text as well as multimedia. Moreover, we teach alphabets through songs and rhymes.





Art and Craft:

Art and Craft activities are designed to help students practice small muscle skills and gain eye hand coordination. It also helps the children to develop their imagination. Art & Craft forms an integral part of our KG curriculum. Different activities like drawing, painting, cutting on shapes, paper tearing, coloring etc. helps to develop muscular skills.







CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

CCA activities enrich education by fostering holistic growth of the students. Various activities are conducted to enable our kindergarteners to discover their interests, develop creativity and build confidence.













Mission For Life:

The motive behind this mission was to create awareness among the kindergarteners with regard to the preservation of our environment. Good Earth/Bad Earth, Go Green Day, Bottle caps collage activity, Ocean Rangers march and making best out of waste were some of the activities conducted during the campaign.





Field Trips:

Field Trips are organized every year and it is a welcome diversion from the daily routine. Children are taken to Toy Town and each child returns home with a surprise gift.





Sports and Yoga:

We introduce our tiny tots to sports gradually beginning with simple activities like walking on a straight line, marching, jogging, playing ring -a - ring - a - roses and land and water. Then, we introduce them to the basic skills of popular games like throw ball, basketball and cricket. These elementary sports and yoga poses make them understand the concept of physical fitness. Timely Workshops

Timely workshops are conducted for teachers to sharpen their skills and improve on the existing teaching method thereby updating the latest teaching techniques in education.
