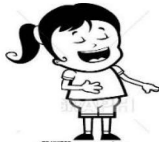

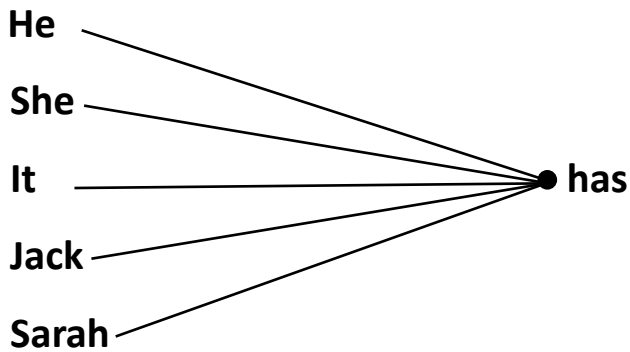

INTRODUCTION: USE OF HAS

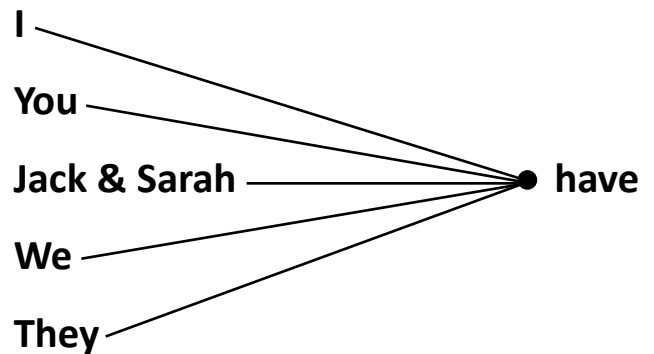
'Has' is used for a single (one) person or a thing except for 'YOU' and 'I'.

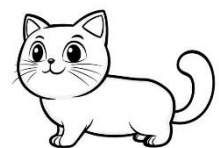

Grammar- Adjectives

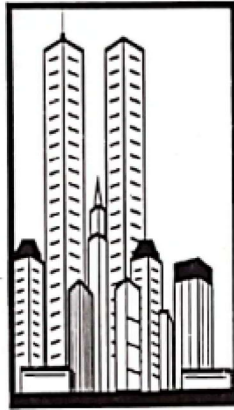
Words that describe a noun or tell us more about it are called **describing words** or **adjectives**.

For Example:



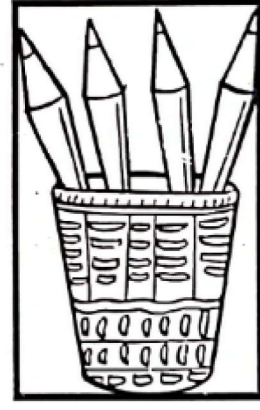
small girl

- c) Avoid framing sentences beginning with '**I**', '**This**' or '**That**'.
- d) Underline the word used in framing the sentence.
- e) The sentence framed should be grammatically correct and make sense.
