**Clarification on Grade 12 Students' (Academic Year 2025-2026)
CBSE Marks/Results/Evaluation**

Dear Parents,

Greetings from IIS Dammam!

It has come to our attention, certain discussions and messages on Social Media Platforms concerning **Grade 12 students' (Academic Year 2025-2026) Final Result Declaration**.

We understand that these discussions may have caused concern and confusion among parents and students.

The school would like to clarify that once the Board issues the Admit Card to students of Grade 10 and 12, all academic and administrative decisions for students are taken in accordance with the Circulars issued by the CBSE Board - its Bye-Laws in the best interests of 33,000 CBSE schools across the globe.

We request parents not to rely on unofficial information, rumors, or unverified social media posts from ANYONE.

Due to the Middle East tensions and subsequent cancellation of Exams, the school had been instructed by CBSE to follow a certain criteria to ensure student evaluation and performance, through the **CBSE Notification No. CBSE/CE/SPPS/2026/2 dated 27 March 2026**, failure to which the below directives are applicable to the schools, if proven the contrary.

9. VERIFICATION OF RECORDS BY CBSE

CBSE may call the records to verify the performance of the students to ensure the correctness and fairness of the uploaded performance.

10. ACTION AGAINST NON-COMPLIANCE

In cases where the school deliberately indulges in practices that are not consistent with fair, unbiased and objective practices of assessment, CBSE reserves the right to cancel such results and to take action against the school. Schools are expected to upload performance of the student without any bias or any favour to any student.

Students who have failed in CBSE written exams as per table above, kindly follow the instructions issued by CBSE circular issued on 15th and 17th May 2026 to address these concerns as this is not an isolated case. **[Updated on School Website]**.

13 Students whose marks have been uploaded by the school and eventually declared failed by the Board, may approach school for a further clarification with the Admit Card and the Marksheet to verify the marks entered.

Parents are encouraged to communicate directly with the school administration for any clarification or concern rather than engaging with speculative discussions online. IISD being a CBSE Centre for Exams for Grades 10 and 12 **[No. 859024/25]** will always be communicating the official updates for **Grades 10 and 12 students** through the **CBSE circulars** which is the only **authorized channel of communication**.

We sincerely request all parents and stakeholders to extend their cooperation in ensuring that the focus remains on the academic progress and well-being of the students, especially during this important academic phase.
